The Mission of this charity is to assist veterans and families to be able to go fishing or sight seeing on Codorus Lake, to relax and unwind and to share fishing skills with other veterans. There is no cost to veterans – programs are free.


Equipment such as fishing poles, worms and lures can be provided as well as water, snacks, suntan lotion, and a bathroom with a privacy curtain can be utilized to change to go swimming. Also available are life jackets for adults and children with prior notice so we know what sizes to bring.

There are three types of vessels available – pontoon boat, tracker bass boat and a kayak. Depending on an individual's skill level, arrangements can be made to assist the veteran, so they have a great time on the Lake. Fishing license is required if fishing. The pontoon boat is wheelchair accessible.
