





This is a 60 shot match fired in two stages with each stage containing one string of slow fire, two strings of timed fire and two strings of rapid fire.

- 25 yards to target
- · B-8 Targets
- 10 Rounds, 10 minutes Slow Fire, 2 Times for a total of 20 shots
- Two (2) five-round strings, 20 Seconds, Timed Fire, 2 Times for a total of 20 shots
- Two (2) five-round strings, 10 Seconds, Rapid-Fire, 2 Times
- There will be a pause between the Timed and Rapid-Fire strings for reloading.

Veterans Lake Fishing

Veterans Lake Fishing has been an active 501 c(3) Charity since 2020.

The Mission of this charity is to assist veterans and families to be able to go fishing or sightseeing on Codorus Lake, to relax and unwind and to share fishing skills with other veterans. There is no cost to veterans - programs are free.

Equipment such as fishing poles, worms and lures will be provided as well as water, snacks, suntan lotion, and bathrooms which are located throughout the Lake. Also available are life jackets for adults

and children with prior notice so we know what sizes to bring.

There are three types of vessels available - pontoon boat, tracker bass boat and some kayaks. Depending on an individual's skill level, arrangements can be made to assist the veteran, so they have a great time on the Lake. Fishing license is required if fishing. The pontoon boat can be wheelchair accessible.


