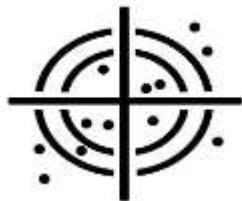

Veterans Lake Fishing

Thanks to Veterans Lake Fishing, the residents in DMVA's six homes can sport new gear for their next outing. For some, that will be in June during the annual TAG Fishing Tournament. Thank you to **Dean Van Zanardi** and **James Schreiber** (of First Capitol) for dropping off the new fishing supplies and delivering a whole lot of fun for our veteran anglers.



Veterans Lake Fishing has been an active 501 c(3) Charity since 2020.

The Mission of this charity is to assist veterans and families to be able to go fishing or sightseeing on Codorus Lake, to relax and unwind and to share fishing skills with other veterans. There is no cost to veterans - programs are free.

Equipment such as fishing poles, worms and lures will be provided as well as water, snacks, suntan lotion, and bathrooms which are located throughout the Lake. Also available are life jackets for adults and children with prior notice so we know what sizes to bring.

There are three types of vessels available - pontoon boat, tracker bass boat and some kayaks. Depending on an individual's skill level, arrangements can be made to assist the veteran, so



they have a great time on the Lake. Fishing license is required if fishing. The pontoon boat can be wheelchair accessible.

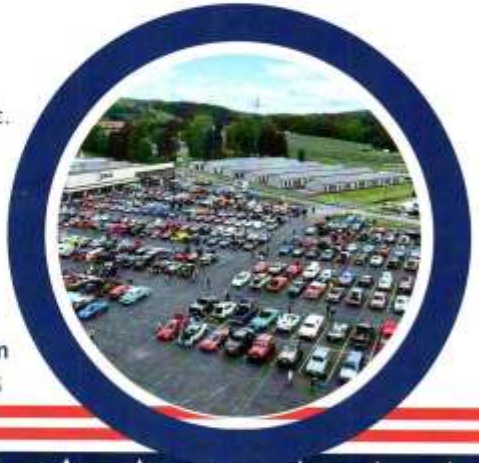

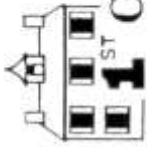
